The Drayton Factory will have production VersaLime available for pickup.

Loading Fee

There is no loading fee.

Paperwork

Customers must fill out required paperwork prior to picking up lime for a particular site. Review and/or return the following documents:

- Lime Removal Agreement. Each year, customers must review, sign and return this agreement.
- Site Suitability Checklist. Customers must complete and return one form for every site where VersaLime is going to be applied.

The First Load

Prior to picking up your first load, please complete and return your paperwork. You will then be sent a card with a number that corresponds to a specific field. Once you receive your number(s) you are free to pick up loads. Trucks can proceed directly to the loading site. Drivers will need to show their assigned number card to the loader operator prior to receiving each load. Please make sure you show the number that corresponds to the field you plan to take the load to.

Loading Hours

Typical loading hours are from 8 AM to 5 PM Monday-Friday, March 15th through around November 1st.

Customers who wish to receive information on VersaLime loading can sign up for text messaging and/or email notifications, section provided in the registration paperwork. Notices will go out when there is a change in loading time.
