Pre-harvest of the 2025 Sugarbeet crop will commence Tuesday, August 12 at 8:00 A.M. Closing time will be 5:00 P.M. or otherwise posted. The prepile schedule will follow this order throughout the season.

Truck Stickers: Truck shift stickers must be affixed to all trucks prior to stockpile harvest. There was confusion in the past regarding low quota. **All stickers have an "N" and an "L" on them. If the "L" was cut off a sticker that we give you, that is a truck that must be shut down in the event we go to low quota.** Please keep that in mind when choosing trucks that stickers are put on. Some growers will lose multiple trucks in the event we go to low quota. Stickers will be monitored and there will not be exceptions. In the event you need a break down truck, it must be approved by ag staff and a breakdown window card will be given at the scale house.

Truck Haul districts and members are broke down as follows:

District 1 (ND N. of Hwy 2)– Travis Knudson
District 2 (MN N of Hwy 21)–George Cariveau
District 3 (ND S. of Hwy 2)- Kirsten Drees

District 4 (MN Hwy 21 S to Hwy 17)- Darren Driscoll
District 5 (MN Hwy 17 to Hwy 2)- Branden Wald
District 6 (MN S. of Hwy 2)- Jake Useldinger

It is imperative to deliver your quota and ON SCHEDULE! Quotas can be shifted with the proper paperwork. Ag Staff has the info to help you with this.
