

Stockpile Harvest Reminders

Shift and Universal Stickers: All trucks must have their 2025 universal stickers plus any station stickers in place and visible on the driver's side of the truck or they won't be unloaded.

Communication: The internet, phone recordings, and text messages will be utilized to keep everyone updated on station schedules and closing times. Internet updates can be accessed from the ACSC home page; updates are generally not found on the members' only page. We will also use the text messaging system and the internet for special messages.

Last Load on Contract: Please inform the scale personnel when the last load of the contract is delivered. The last Load for a contract can also be selected on the opening screen when logged into "Shareholder Records". This information is entered into our computer system, which helps provide a "real-time" yield report that helps management make important harvest decisions. Decisions on pile heights and acre reduction plans come directly from this information.

Sample Reports are generally updated daily at midnight. They can be viewed in the members' only section of the internet.

Ticket Corrections: Any requested weight adjustments must be made onsite before the truck leaves the site. All ticket corrections must be signed by the agriculturalist assigned to the site.

Definitions of Terminology

On Shift-Deliveries are to be made to the receiving station to which contracts are assigned, on the shift that the harvest unit has been assigned to, with only the number of trucks that have been allocated to the harvest unit.

Off-shift deliveries are to be made to the receiving station to which the contracts are assigned. Deliveries are accepted anytime during the day, regardless of the shift the harvest unit has been assigned to, using the number of trucks that have been allocated to the harvest unit.

Open Haul-Deliveries are accepted from any receiving station anytime during the day, regardless of the shift the harvest unit has been assigned. Harvest units may use as many trucks as they want.
