This letter is to inform you of upcoming road construction around the Drayton factory that will impact local traffic throughout the summer. Earlier this spring, Pembina County received state funding to reconstruct County Highway 44 from Highway 66 to 82nd St NE. The project also includes reconstruction of 82nd St NE from Highway 44 to the DTN Yard North scale.

During this work, portions of these roads will be closed. Below is the current construction and reopening schedule:

- **May 25** — Construction begins. Highway 44 will be closed from Highway 66 north to the factory. All traffic to the factory will be detoured to enter from the north.
- **August 10** — Scheduled reopening of Highway 44 from the DTN factory south employee entrance to Highway 66. At this time, Highway 44 north of the employee entrance to 82nd St NE, as well as 82nd St NE itself, will close for construction. During this period, **no loading or hauling of lime will be permitted.**
- **September 14** — Scheduled reopening of all of Highway 44 and 82nd St NE. Some remaining non-substantial work will continue through the end of September. Lime loading and hauling will resume.

If any significant changes occur, an updated notice will be provided.
