Pre-harvest will start on Friday, August 14, 2026. In the Drayton district, each receiving station will open at 8:00 am on the first day of prepile, and 7:00 am each day after. Closing time will be 4:30 pm or otherwise posted. The schedule for each DTN receiving station is below.

- Actual factory slice, weather, and beet inventories may affect actual dates.
- The schedule and quotas are made to keep enough inventory for the factories to continue to slice along with limiting the inventory, so beets are reloaded and processed before deteriorating. It is imperative that beets are delivered when they are scheduled. If you are unable to deliver your quota, you can transfer your quota within the group/site as needed.
- **Hauler ID Cards:** Agriculturalists will issue them before pre-pile harvest if the shareholder has met all requirements to receive them.
- **Deferred Payments** must be turned in at least 24 hours before the first delivery on that contract.
- **Truck Identification Form:** Any grower delivering to **Minnesota** receiving station needs to fill out the truck identification form which was mailed out by the office coordinator. Please use the return envelope included in the mailing to return the completed forms to the office coordinator by **August 13**.
- **Pre-harvest Intervals:** Please pay attention to pre-harvest intervals for pesticides that have been applied to your sugar beets. Call your agriculturalist if you have questions.
